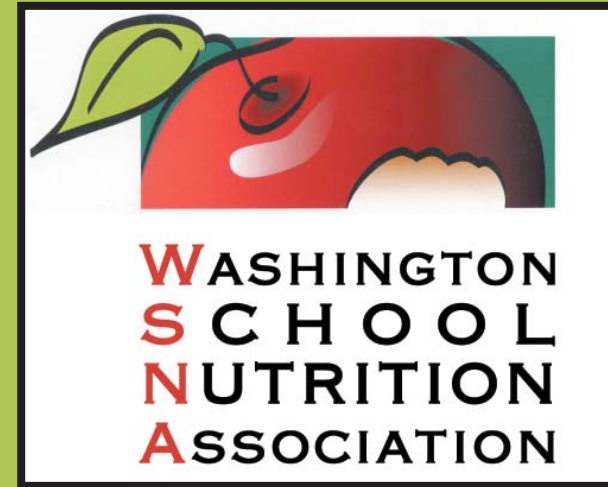

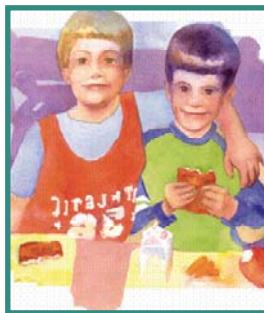
The mission of the Washington School Nutrition Association, as a leader in child nutrition, is to advance good nutrition for all children.
